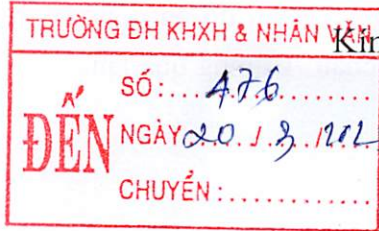

V/v thông báo chương trình
AUN Summer Camp 2025 – NTU



Kính gửi:

- Các trường đại học thành viên;
- Phân hiệu Đại học Quốc gia Thành phố Hồ Chí Minh tại tỉnh Bến Tre.

Đại học Quốc gia Thành phố Hồ Chí Minh (ĐHQG-HCM) nhận được thông tin từ Ban Thư ký Mạng lưới các trường đại học Đông Nam Á (AUN) về chương trình AUN Summer Camp 2025 – Nanyang Technological University (NTU) (Chương trình), thuộc khuôn khổ chương trình AUN Summer Camp 2025 của AUN. Chương trình gồm 02 nội dung chính: Khởi nghiệp và Sáng tạo đổi mới (Hoạt động 1); Tương lai bền vững (Hoạt động 2). Sinh viên được đề cử chỉ được chọn 01 trong 02 nội dung này để tham gia.

Thông tin về Chương trình như sau:

1. Thời gian và địa điểm:

- Hoạt động 1:
 - + Tại Singapore: Từ ngày 25/6/2025 đến ngày 14/7/2025.
 - + Tại Hà Nội, Việt Nam: Từ ngày 15/7/2025 đến ngày 26/7/2025.
- Hoạt động 2: Tại Singapore, từ ngày 25/6/2025 đến ngày 12/7/2025.

2. Chủ đề:

- Chủ đề chung: Phát triển những công dân sẵn sàng cho tương lai với tư duy toàn cầu tại châu Á hội nhập.

- Hoạt động 1: Khởi nghiệp và Sáng tạo đổi mới.
- Hoạt động 2: Tương lai bền vững.

3. Nội dung:

- Hoạt động 1: Chương trình hè 4.5 tuần giúp các sinh viên tham gia phát triển kỹ năng tương lai. Các sinh viên sẽ học tập tại NTU, tham gia khóa khởi nghiệp, hội thảo và giải quyết vấn đề SDG trong nhóm đa văn hóa. Tiếp đó, họ sẽ trải nghiệm học thuật, văn hóa và nền công nghiệp tại một thành phố ASEAN.

- Hoạt động 2: Chương trình hè kéo dài 2.5 tuần được thiết kế để trang bị kỹ năng và kiến thức nhằm thúc đẩy chuyển đổi xanh. Tại NTU, sinh viên sẽ tham gia khóa học về bền vững, các hội thảo về năng lực liên văn hóa và sau đó áp dụng những kiến thức này để giải quyết một vấn đề môi trường tại châu Á thông qua làm việc nhóm.

4. Thông tin chi tiết:

Thông tin chi tiết về Chương trình tại tệp đính kèm.

5. Số lượng sinh viên: NTU mời ĐHQG-HCM đề cử tối đa 06 sinh viên. Căn cứ danh sách đề cử từ ĐHQG-HCM, NTU sẽ thẩm định hồ sơ ứng viên và quyết định danh sách sinh viên được lựa chọn tham gia Chương trình.

6. Điều kiện dự tuyển:

- Là sinh viên bậc đại học chính quy đã hoàn thành ít nhất 02 học kỳ tại các đơn vị thành viên và trực thuộc của ĐHQG-HCM.

- Có mong muốn thực hiện nghiên cứu hoặc theo học chương trình sau đại học.

- Có thành tích học tập tốt, điểm trung bình tích lũy từ 2.81 trở lên trên thang 4.0 hoặc từ 7.1 trở lên trên thang 10.

- Có minh chứng trình độ tiếng Anh là một trong các minh chứng sau đây:

+ Chứng chỉ IELTS từ 6.0 trở lên với điểm môn Viết từ 6.0 trở lên.

+ Chứng chỉ PBT từ 570 điểm trở lên, TOEFL iBT từ 90 điểm trở lên hoặc TOEFL CBT từ 237 điểm trở lên.

Lưu ý: Đối với chứng chỉ IELTS và chứng chỉ TOEFL, NTU chỉ nhận chứng chỉ được cấp sau ngày 25/4/2023.

+ Chứng chỉ PTE Academic từ 55 điểm trở lên.

+ Chứng chỉ SAT (từ tháng 3/2016 trở đi) từ 1250 điểm trở lên.

+ Giấy xác nhận sinh viên đủ trình độ tiếng Anh tham gia Chương trình từ đơn vị đề cử sinh viên.

- Có kinh nghiệm trong các vị trí lãnh đạo hoặc kinh nghiệm tham gia các hoạt động cộng đồng.

- Có thư đề cử sinh viên từ cấp Khoa sinh viên đang theo học.

7. Chi phí:

Hoạt động 1: Hoạt động này được tài trợ bởi Quỹ Temasek thông qua học bổng TF LEARN có trị giá lên đến 7.600 SGD (*tương đương khoảng 145.700.000 VND*).

Trong khuôn khổ Chương trình, học bổng này sẽ được dùng chi trả cho những mục sau đây của Hoạt động 1:

- Tại Singapore: Học phí và chi phí của các hoạt động văn hóa xã hội thuộc khuôn khổ Hoạt động 1; chi phí chỗ ở thuộc khuôn khổ Hoạt động 1 nếu sinh viên được đề cử hoàn tất thủ tục đăng ký trước ngày 09/4/2025.

- Tại Việt Nam: Chi phí chỗ ở, học phí, chi phí của các hoạt động văn hóa xã hội và chi phí các chuyến thăm doanh nghiệp thuộc khuôn khổ Hoạt động 1.

- 1.500 SGD (*tương đương khoảng 28.700.000 VND*) tiền mặt cho mỗi sinh viên tham gia để chi trả cho chi phí vé máy bay và chi phí sinh hoạt.

Cơ sở đào tạo sinh viên chi trả chi phí bảo hiểm cho sinh viên tham gia như sau: 500.000 đồng/sinh viên. Sinh viên tham gia chi trả phần còn lại của chi phí bảo hiểm và các chi phí khác.

Hoạt động 2: Ban Tổ chức chi trả cho những mục sau đây của Hoạt động 2, trị giá lên đến 5.500 SGD (*tương đương khoảng 105.400.000 VND*):

- Học phí và chi phí của các hoạt động văn hóa xã hội thuộc khuôn khổ Hoạt động 2; chi phí chỗ ở thuộc khuôn khổ Hoạt động 2 nếu sinh viên được đề cử hoàn tất thủ tục đăng ký trước ngày 09/4/2025.

Cơ sở đào tạo sinh viên chi trả chi phí vé máy bay, bảo hiểm cho sinh viên tham gia như sau:

- Chi phí vé máy bay: Tối thiểu 5.000.000 đồng/sinh viên.

- Bảo hiểm: 500.000 đồng/sinh viên.

Sinh viên tham gia chi trả phần còn lại của chi phí vé máy bay, phần còn lại của chi phí bảo hiểm và các chi phí khác.

Lưu ý: đối với cả hai Hoạt động, các cơ sở đào tạo phụ trách hướng dẫn sinh viên của đơn vị thực hiện thủ tục chi trả vé máy bay và bảo hiểm.

8. Hồ sơ dự tuyển:

- Biểu mẫu thông tin sinh viên (*mẫu đính kèm*).

- Bảng điểm tiếng Việt và tiếng Anh có xác nhận, đóng dấu của cơ sở đào tạo.

- Minh chứng trình độ ngoại ngữ như nêu trên.

- Minh chứng kinh nghiệm lãnh đạo, hoạt động xã hội.

- File hình ảnh sinh viên sử dụng được trong passport.

- Bản scan passport có hiệu lực ít nhất 06 tháng sau ngày 15/7/2025.

- Sơ yếu lý lịch tiếng Anh (CV).

9. Quy trình nộp hồ sơ:

Bước 1: Các đơn vị gửi công văn đề cử tối đa 01 sinh viên kèm theo biểu mẫu đề cử (*mẫu đính kèm – bao gồm 02 trang*), hồ sơ dự tuyển đủ điều kiện về Ban Đối ngoại và Phát triển dự án (ĐN&PTDA), ĐHQG-HCM và qua email: tranhung@vnuhcm.edu.vn **trước ngày 02/4/2025**.

Bước 2: ĐHQG-HCM xét tuyển các hồ sơ dự tuyển và đề cử 06 sinh viên có hồ sơ phù hợp nhất với các điều kiện dự tuyển của Chương trình đến NTU.

Bước 3: ĐHQG-HCM thông báo kết quả đề cử đến các đơn vị có sinh viên được đề cử.

Bước 4: Các sinh viên được đề cử hoàn thiện hồ sơ dưới sự hướng dẫn của đơn vị **trước ngày 09/4/2025**.

Bước 5: ĐHQG-HCM thông báo kết quả trúng tuyển đến các đơn vị có sinh viên trúng tuyển sau ngày 08/5/2025.

ĐHQG-HCM đề nghị các đơn vị phổ biến thông tin Chương trình đến các đối tượng có quan tâm và đề cử tối đa 01 sinh viên đủ điều kiện kèm theo công văn đề cử, biểu mẫu đề cử (*mẫu đính kèm*), hồ sơ dự tuyển gửi về Ban ĐN&PTDA, ĐHQG-HCM và qua email: tranhung@vnuhcm.edu.vn **trước ngày 02/4/2025**.

Sau thời hạn nêu trên, đơn vị nào chưa gửi thông tin và hồ sơ đề cử về Ban ĐN&PTDA, ĐHQG-HCM qua email: tranhung@vnuhcm.edu.vn thì được xem như đơn vị không có đề cử sinh viên tham gia Chương trình.

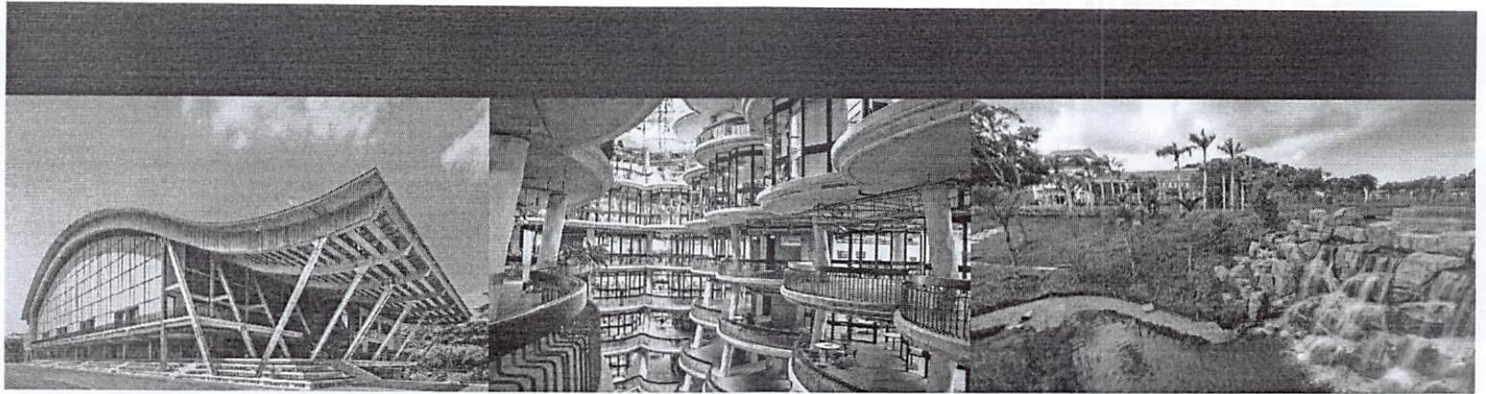

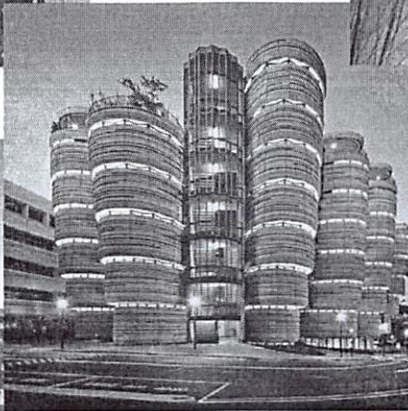
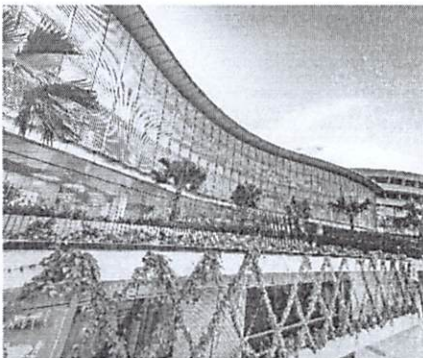
ABOUT NTU SINGAPORE

NOMINATION GUIDELINES AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nomination Guidelines for Partner Institutions

- NTU will only review student applications that are nominated and formally submitted to NTU Office of Global Education & Mobility Education (OGEM) by the International Relations Office of Partner Institutions.
- We welcome Partner Institutions to select good students based on the eligibility criteria.
- The International Relations Office of Partner Institutions may nominate up to **six (6) students** who meet the eligibility criteria.
- Submission of nomination does not guarantee an acceptance into the programme. Nominees will be assessed on a competitive basis.
- Please rank your nominations and provide reasons for your ranking. Offers will be made from Thu, 8 May 2025 and students from reserve list will be considered till Thu, 15 May 2025.
- Please complete the attached nomination form and return it to us by **Fri, 4 April 2025**.
- **The nominees should be from different faculties/schools within the nominating Partner Institution.**

Eligibility Criteria for the ASEAN Summer @NTU Programme

- Applicants should have an interest to do research and/ or pursue a post-graduate programme.
- Applicants must be full-time, matriculated undergraduate students from one of the ASEAN University Network (AUN) member universities.
- Applicants must have completed at least two (2) semesters of study at home university, with proof of academic results.
- Applicants should possess the following:
 - a) An excellent academic record,
 - b) A good command of the English Language. English proficiency level is based on NTU admission standards. Partner institution may provide a letter to confirm the standard. (see "English Proficiency Requirement" on page 11),
 - c) A track record of student leadership roles and/or contribution to community service,
 - d) A Recommendation Letter from a faculty of their home institution, and
 - e) An up-to-date Curriculum Vitae of the individual's accomplishments.

ASEAN Summer @NTU 2025

Building Bridges: Innovation, Culture, and Sustainability in ASEAN

The ASEAN Summer @NTU offers participating students the opportunity to select from two dynamic summer tracks.

I. Entrepreneurship & Innovation Track

A comprehensive summer programme over 4.5 weeks has been specially curated to build and enhance key skillsets that are important for students to be Future Ready. ASEAN youths shall first travel to Singapore to meet up with NTU and international students for cultural and academic immersion. Here at NTU, they will take an Entrepreneurship course, attend workshops and lectures covering design/ systems thinking and intercultural competences and then apply the learnings to solve a Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) issue within a multicultural and multidisciplinary team.

For the second segment of their learning, they will participate in an academic, cultural and industrial immersive experience in an ASEAN city and gain a deeper appreciation about Singapore and the selected ASEAN host country. This will cultivate a better understanding and sensitivity to diverse cultures and perspectives. In 2025, this segment of the programme will be held in Hanoi, Vietnam.

1. Coursework on 'Professional Development and Occupational Success' Pillar

At NTU, the participants will gain a fundamental understanding of the entrepreneurial process, of how entrepreneurs start and implement their business ideas and this will instill in them an entrepreneurial mindset posture for the future. They will attend workshops and lectures covering design/ systems thinking and intercultural competences and then apply the learnings to work on an SDG-related project and build a business model. They will then pitch the business solution to their peers and the academics.

2. Experiential Learning on 'Role and Impact of Asia in the World (Singapore's Perspective) and Intercultural Competence' Pillar

The programme will culminate in a two-week immersive experience in Hanoi, Vietnam where the participants continue their learning to build actionable strategies for their business models to penetrate into the Vietnamese market and fast track new business ventures. They will embark on a co-curricular learning journey interacting with entrepreneurs, business leaders and industry experts through visits to innovative businesses in both high growth technology sectors and transforming traditional core sectors. This programme also features cultural appreciation activities, excursions to important heritage sites and collaborative teamwork to deepen cross-cultural connections.

3. Programme Funding

The **Entrepreneurship & Innovation** track is supported by the Temasek Foundation through TF LEaRN Scholarship.

1. Each TF LEaRN Scholarship is tenable for the summer term at NTU.
2. Each TF LEaRN Scholarship is worth up to SGD7,600 and the benefits cover the following:
 - Singapore:
 - Programme fee at NTU (Tuition and socio-cultural activities)
 - Accommodation*
 - Vietnam:
 - Programme fee at Vietnam (Tuition, socio-cultural activities and corporate visits)
 - Accommodation
 - Financial award of SGD1,500 in cash as:
 - subsidy for airfare costs
 - subsistence or basic living allowance for the duration of the programme

The terms and conditions of the TF LEaRN Scholarship will be reflected in the award letter to be signed by the awardee.

II. Sustainable Futures Track

In response to the global shift towards sustainability, a summer programme over 2.5 weeks is designed to build skills and knowledge to drive green transformation. Here at NTU, they will take a sustainability course, attend workshops on intercultural competences and then through collaborative teamwork apply the learnings to solve an environmental issue facing Asia.

1. Coursework on Sustainable Futures

Participants will gain insights into Earth's systems and major environmental topics that relate to the Earth. They will attend lectures and tutorials covering earth cycles and systems, green cities, environmental resource management and environmental engineering then apply the learnings to work on a video assignment related to an environmental issue.

2. Programme Funding

NTU is fully funding this programme for students nominated by AUN member universities. This funding will cover all ground expenses, including tuition and accommodation* in Singapore.

1. Each study award is tenable for the summer term at NTU.
2. Each successful candidate shall receive a study award worth up to SGD5,500 and the benefits include the following:
 - Singapore:
 - Programme fee at NTU (Tuition and socio-cultural activities)
 - Accommodation*
3. Additional support of SGD350 for students from Cambodia, Laos and Myanmar (CLM) to cover airfare costs.

The terms and conditions of the study award will be reflected in the award letter to be signed by the awardee.

** Students who apply by Wed, 9 April 2025 will be guaranteed on-campus accommodation with full housing fee waiver.*

III. Events and Activities

ASEAN Summer participants are required to participate in **ALL** activities organised during the programme.

IV. Reflections and Journal Reports

Participants are required to periodically write down their reflections as well as to produce a journal, with photos, of **1,500 - 2,000 words** at the end of the ASEAN Summer @NTU programme on their immersion experience.

V. Post-Programme

After the study programme ends, the participants must be prepared to:

- share their learning experiences through seminars, blogs, university websites, presentations at their home university and country,
- complete online surveys regarding their progress and development.

Only applicants who have been officially nominated by their home institution for the ASEAN Summer @NTU are eligible to apply.

Supporting documents

All required information and documents as follows must be submitted online together with the application form:

1. Scanned copy of the latest official transcript (signed by the Registrar and includes home university's seal) in English, reflecting all courses taken in PDF format (<600kb).
2. Colour passport-size photo in JPEG format (<60kb; 400(W) x 514(H) pixels). The photo must be clear and sharp and taken within the last 3 months.
3. Scanned copy of passport information page in JPEG format (<200kb). Passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the commencement of the second segment of the programme in Vietnam.
4. Up-to-date Curriculum Vitae in PDF format (<600kb)
5. Proof of English proficiency (See Page 11 for more information) and/or letter from home institution certifying applicant's proficiency in English.

<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>On-campus accommodation is <u>guaranteed</u> with full housing fee waiver if you apply by Wed, 9 April 2025.</p> <p>You do not need to apply for on-campus accommodation separately through the Office of Campus Housing (OCH) website. The online application is meant only for FULL-TIME students.</p> <p>NTU has 24 Halls of Residence that are home to some 14,200 undergraduates. They offer hostel-styled accommodation and are co-ed by floor or wing.</p> <p>ASEAN Summer participants will be allocated randomly to rooms in an NTU undergraduate Hall of Residence based on double occupancy (twin-sharing).
