About the programme

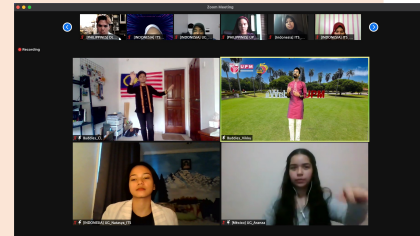

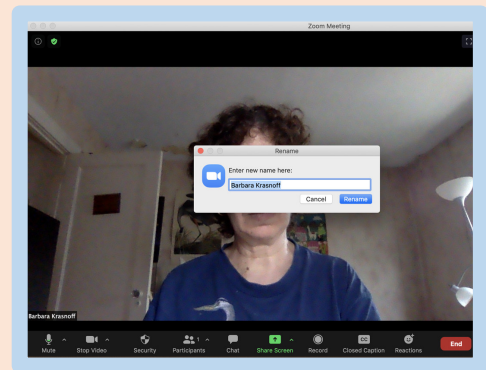
